

Supplies needed for Art 59 / Art 44, S70Z – Fall 2009

2 canvas boards (16 x 20 inches)

3 canvas boards (18 x 24 inches)

Pint of *odorless* turpentine (Turpenoid)

Colors (approximate size: 37 ml)

ivory black

titanium white

yellow ochre

cobalt blue

burnt sienna

permanent green

cadmium yellow

alizarin crimson

Three jars with lids

Brushes (white bristle):

6 round

8 round

4 filbert

6 filbert

a rag or two

paper towels

a bar of plain soap

a shirt or smock to wear over your clothes

a palette (preferably with a finished surface)

a palette knife (or some simple scraping tool to clean your palette)

Clean-up routine

1. Wipe paint off brushes with turp-rag, rinse in turp, wipe again with rag.
2. Stir used turp, then pour it into turp storage jar.
3. Pour used medium into medium storage jar.
4. Scrape remaining paint off palette onto a paper towel, wipe palette with turp soaked paper towel, then place all paper towels in trash container.
5. Bring soap and brushes to sink. Wet brush, soap it up, rinse. Repeat until color disappears from soap residue. (This can also be done at home. After the brushes have been wiped with turp, wrap them in a paper towel, bring them home and wash with soap)
6. Place your jars in the bottom of your locker.
7. Place all your other stuff in your locker.
8. Remove any stuff you brought into the room. Either throw it out, or take it with you.
9. Put your work in the painting rack or your locker.
