

## **Class Exercise**

### **Motion Guide**

1. On Frame 1, create an object or import a graphic and then convert it to a symbol
2. Insert a keyframe around 40, then add a motion guide layer
3. Select the pencil tool and draw a path on the work area of the motion guide layer.
4. Click on frame 1 of the object layer. Select 'arrow' from the toolbar and select the image object, moving it toward the top of the path you just drew until it 'snaps to' the beginning of the path.
5. Click on frame 40 of the layer, then select the object again on the work area, then drag it to the end of the path until it 'snaps to' the other end. Double click on frame 1 of the object layer, select the Tweening tab, select 'motion' , check 'tween scaling' 'synchronize symbols' and 'snap to guide' and then 'ok'.

### **Text Morph**

1. Select Frame 1 and type your word
2. Select the word and Modify Break apart (twice)
3. Select Frame 40 and type second word
4. Select the word and Modify Break apart (twice)
5. Select frame 1 again and shape tween selecting Blend “Angular” from the frame property box.
6. Repeat for frame 40
