WORK IN PROGRESS OUTSIDE KCC' ORIENTIAL BLVD. AND SHORE BLVD GATES

The College Community,

There is a joint 2 year project by the Department of Design & Construction, DDC and the Department of Environmental Protection, DEP, for the installation of new water mains on Oriental Boulevard. At the same time, there is sporadic sewer maintenance being done throughout the Manhattan Beach community.

National Grid is also moving gas lines and installing new gas lines at selected locations in our neighborhood.

The DDC project addresses the water main replacements on Oriental Boulevard, between Corbin Place and Pembroke Street. The anticipated construction timeframe for this project is tentatively scheduled from April, 2022 through April, 2024 (subject to change).

Construction work hours will be from 6 AM to 4 PM. Noise and use of heavy equipment and machinery are expected. Street parking may be temporarily eliminated in order to facilitate work operations. Detours may be necessary during certain operations.

Please drive and walk carefully during this construction phase as there may be steel plates covering work areas.

I will provide updates accordingly, especially if and when any portion of this work will directly affect access through our Oriental Boulevard and/or Shore Boulevard gates.
