Transportation Completed Over 500 KCC employees and students have Affordable and Sustainable Alternatives to joined the carpool database, and over 300 **Driving** have received customized transit itineraries. Kingsborough Community College was awarded the Clean Air NY Campus Award by 511NY Rideshare and Clean Air NY. These programs help commuters find easy, affordable and sustainable alternatives to driving alone. KCC provides free continuous yellow bus service during peak class hours between three key Metropolitan Transit Authority subway stations and campus. Completed Use of clean and alternative fuels for Use of bicycles for patrols to patrol campus. campus vehicle fleet. In Progress Reduce the campus' vehicle GHG emissions by replacing 60% of the current vehicle fleet with clean fuel technology vehicles.

Purchase Segway's for patrols to reduce the need for automobiles.

Encourage the use of bicycles as a means of getting to campus and to various buildings by installing bike racks.

Distribution of literature regarding traveling via clean air options.

Explore the possibility of purchasing hybrid buses and /or electric shuttle buses to replace existing school buses used to shuttle students to local subway stations.

In Progress

Increase the number of students/staff/faculty who use bicycles to travel to and within the KCC Campus

Promote bicycle usage as an option to new students faculty/staff members via open houses/seminars/web site.

Add bike racks on campus which to increase the total number of bike slots.

In accordance with NYC DOT, design oncampus bike lanes that will enable bicyclists to travel safely throughout campus

Work with NYPD to offer bicyclists the opportunity to have bikes etched with a security code for additional protection of their bikes.
