



Wave Athletics Highlights 2008-2009

- Men's Soccer placed third in CUNY and ninth in Region XV.
- Women's Tennis advanced to the NJCAA Region XV Championships where they placed **first**. They won 25 out of 27 matches to win the Region XV Championships.
 - Erina Kikuchi, Nina Mayevska, Epraksi Yushkova, Arielle Kamin, Taylor Manson were selected to the Region XV All Tournament Team.
 - **Erina Kikuchi is the Region XV Women's Tennis Player of the Year**
 - **Head Coach Barry Goldsmith was selected the NJCAA Region XV Women's Tennis Coach of the Year**
 - They advanced to the National Championships which will be held at Tucson, AZ from May 2, 2008-May 7, 2008
 - This is the first time in Kingsborough's history that the whole Women's Tennis Team made Nationals.
- Women's Volleyball advanced to the CUNY Championship Semi-Finals and placed fourth in CUNY.
 - They also placed ninth in Region XV; this was their best regional season in the last fifteen years.
- Men's Cross Country Team captured second place in the CUNY Championships.
 - *They also captured fourth place in the Region XV Championships.*
- Men's Basketball *won* the CUNY Championships.
 - **Tarik Alassari and Derrison Anthony, received CUNY All Star and All Region Honorable Mention**
 - **Iouri Mataskov is CUNY Player of the Year, he also received All Region First Team Honors. This will allow him to apply for All-America Honors**
 - **Head Coach Hassan Duncombe was selected the CUNY Men's Basketball Coach of the Year for Community Colleges**
 - They have also advanced to the NJCAA Region XV Championships, where they placed **fourth**

- Women's Basketball advanced to the CUNY Championship Finals and placed second
 - **Esther Farmer and Maycarolyn Oyangoren received CUNY All Star Honors**
 - They have also advanced to the NJCAA Region XV ChampionshipsThe Women's Basketball Team has not been to the NJCAA Region XV Championships in a very long time

This is the most CUNY ALL STAR Honors that Men's and Women's Basketball has every received in one year

- Men's Indoor Track and Field Team advanced to the CUNY Championships
