Program and Partnership Updates

Fall 2023 was a productive semester building partnerships and representing Kingsborough throughout the borough in collaboration with our community partners.

We were able to reach our community members through a new partnership with Catholic Charities of New York. We hosted multiple events targeting newly arrived immigrants who were interested in a variety of continuing education programs and certifications. We also ran workshops with many social workers and job developers to equip them with all appropriate information and contacts for their patrons.

We participated and attended Mayor Eric Adams "Breaking Bread Building Bonds" event at SkyWise Restaurant in Sheepshead Bay. The event was geared towards community bonding and to discuss improvements for NYC.

We reestablished a relationship with the **Brighton Neighborhood Association**, and discussed our participation in the annual **Brighton Jubilee 2024** festival that hosts over 100K people in the neighborhood. We also discussed hosting workshops to recruit students into Kingsborough for a variety of programs.

On October 17th and October 24th, the College Experience ran twice at Sheepshead Bay Library with over 100 participants. The event expanded regular programming to include representatives from the ESL department to introduce different programs available for English learners. We created several marketing materials in Russian to meet the demand of the heavy influx of Russian speaking immigrants. Workforce Trainings

CUNY Fatherhood Academy (CFA)

On December 15th, the CUNY Fatherhood Academy held an acknowledgement ceremony for the current GED cohort. Nine students successfully completed the 16-week GED prep program and are in the process of testing and/or applying for jobs and college. We are currently recruiting for the College and Career Prep program for 18–30-year-old fathers who hold their GED/HS diploma. SNAP Venture Program

The New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) provided the division with an additional award of \$212,500 for a third year of the SNAP Venture V Program.
