The following information is submitted as pertinent to explain and illustrate the proposed changes to our curriculum.

- 1) Department: Health, Physical Education & Recreation, Courses:
 - a. COH 1200 Critical Issues in Community Health (3 credits)
 - b. COH 1300 Epidemiology (3 credits)
 - c. COH 2000 Community Health Interventions (3 credits)
 - d. COH 91E1 Field Experience in Community Health (3 credits)
- 2) The aforementioned courses in the Community Health program are offered to majors as the core introductory exposure to the fields of community and public health. Pre-requisites were created in order to increase the integrity of the major and to make it more attractive to four-year schools to accept all credits from the major for transfer. However, the implementation of the prerequisites caused unintended effects, such as preventing COH majors from completing their degree requirements, excluding non-majors from registering for courses, and recruiting new majors into the program. The new changes allow the program to maintain sequencing while also maintaining integrity and inclusion.
