

Curriculum Proposal to adjust ECO in Business Administration & Accounting

DATE:

Please consider the following proposal to be added to the agenda for the Spring Curriculum Committee as a CHANGE IN DEGREE REQUIREMENTS.

- 1. The current department requirement of ECO 1400 (Money and Banking) in both the AS in BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION and the AS in ACCOUNTING degrees be replaced with ECO 1200 (Macroeconomics), and
- 2. In addition, the "Highly recommended" notation for ECO 1200 (Macroeconomics) in the appropriate (Group D) flexible core group be replaced with ECO 1300 (Microeconomics).

## Rationale:

In Fall 2014, the department converted two of its AAS degrees to AS—specifically BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION and ACCOUNTING. During this conversion, ECO 1400 was retained as a department requirement (as it is not a liberal arts course) whereas ECO 1200 (which is liberal arts) was approved as a Pathways Group A course and marked as "highly recommended." Unfortunately, this has resulted in a significant number of students not taking ECO 1200 (an essential course for business and accounting majors) nor ECO 1300 (Microeconomics) which still remains an elective course in the department although available in Pathways.

Given that the combination of ECO 1200 and 1300 more closely matches the degree requirements of four-year colleges both within CUNY and elsewhere, and that ECO 1200 must remain an essential component of our two degrees, the department has decided to adjust the two degrees to switch these courses as follows: Make ECO 1200 a department requirement to eliminate confusion, and highly recommend ECO 1300 as a Pathways group option. (Remove ECO 1400 from the degree but keep it as an elective offering.)
