The English Department is proposing to change the requirements for the English concentration

## Rationale for Change:

This change would make the English concentration consistent with the other concentration where the degree requirements are 21 liberal arts requirements including the liberal arts seminar and 9 concentration credits of 3 English courses which remain the same. This changes across the liberal arts concentration should improve enrolment through greater consistency and better advising. Students will not be able to utilize liberal arts and concentration requirements to also meet pathway requirements.
