Date: September 16, 2022
The Liberal Arts- Spanish Concentration is being updated to reflect the changes made to the Liberal Arts degree requirements which effect all of the Concentrations in the program.

## Rationale for Change:

This change would make the Spanish concentration consistent with the other concentration where the degree requirements are 21 liberal arts requirements including the liberal arts seminar and 9 concentration credits of 3 Spanish courses, which remain the same. These changes across the liberal arts concentrations should improve enrolment through greater consistency and better advising. Students will not be able to utilize liberal arts and concentration requirements to also meet pathway requirements.
