**Re:** Proposed Deletion of the Liberal Arts Children's Studies Concentration

**Date**: October 16, 2022

The Children's Studies Concentration is no longer relevant to the needs of the Education Program or the College and has unused for several years now. It also no longer transfers to programs at the senior colleges. Furthermore, it is extremely difficult to complete given our current Liberal Arts degree requirements.

Proposed sunset date: Fall 2023

Although there has not been any faculty or departmental support for this concentration for a number of years there are students currently enrolled.

Upon approval by the Curriculum Committee the Education Program within the Behavioral Science Department will:

- Stop enrolling students in the Concentration starting Spring 2023.
