Rationale for Change:

Past enrollment trends have shown that nonmajors are interested in enrolling and are often successful in computer-based graphic design classes like Art 73, which utilizes the popular publishing software Adobe InDesign, but may not enroll due to the listed prerequisite. While it is recommended that Graphic Design and Illustration majors take Art 55 first as part of their Graphic Design and Illustration, including permissions in the prerequisite section would also allow motivated nonmajors to take this class.
