RE: Changes in Prerequisites for EDC 2400 – Teaching Emergent Bilinguals

The Department of Behavioral Sciences is proposing changes in Prerequisites for EDC 2400 – Teaching Emergent Bilinguals

For Birth-2nd Grade Concentration: Prerequisite: EDC 4000, EDC 2100, EDC 3200 with a minimum grade of "C".

For 1st-6th Grade Concentration: Prerequisite: EDC 4200, EDC 3100, EDC 2900 with a minimum grade of "C".

For PreK-12th Grade Special Education Concentration: EDC 4200, EDC 3100, EDC 5100 with a minimum grade of "C".

Rationale for Changes:

EDC 2400 is a new bilingual pedagogy course that was previously included in our degree as a Suggested Elective course. This course has recently gained approval by the chairs of BC's Early Childhood and Arts Education (ECAE) and Childhood Bilingual and Special Education (CBSE) departments to be accepted upon transfer toward their Early Childhood and Childhood Education degrees. As such,

we propose changing this course to a degree requirement for all concentrations. The official articulation agreements are slated to be signed once the changes in degree are finalized and this course becomes a degree requirement.
