# **Rationale for Changes:**

For A.S. Education Studies Students:

*EDC 2800* is a requirement for the Early Childhood/Childcare A.S. major that is now in the process of being sunsetted. **This course has recently gained approval by the chair of BC's Early Childhood and Arts Education (ECAE) department to be accepted upon transfer toward their Early Childhood <b>degree.** Therefore, we propose changing this course's designation to a concentration requirement for Education Studies Birth-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade concentration students. The official articulation agreement is slated to be signed once the change in degree is finalized and these courses become concentration requirements.

Due to the reorganization of our program's curriculum sequence, EDC 2800 will have revised prerequisites to ensure that the coursework and learning outcomes are sequenced logically to support students' learning progression.
