The Departm	ent of Communications & Performing Arts and the Department of Behavioral Sciences are proposing a Reintroduction of a Deleted Course - SPE 01600: Survey of Speech, Language and Hearing Disorders

Rationale for Changes:

KCC's Speech Program Director and Department of Communications & Performing Arts Chair have agreed to reintroduce *SPE 01600: Survey of Speech, Language and Hearing Disorders* into the college catalog. This course will ensure that our Birth-2nd Grade concentration students gain valuable knowledge pertaining to sensory disabilities in young children. It has been approved by the Chair of BC's Early Childhood and Arts Education (ECAE) department to be accepted upon transfer as *SPE 2100: Survey of Speech, Language and Hearing Disorders*, a requirement for their Early Childhood degree. The official articulation agreement will be signed once the degree changes are finalized and this course becomes a concentration requirement.
