The Department of Mathematics & Computer Science is proposing a change in Course Prerequisite for Computer Organization and Assembly Language Programming (CS 1400):

Prerequisite: CS 1200 with a grade of "C" or higher

TO:

Prerequisite: CS 1200 with a grade of "C+" or higher

Rationale for Change:

The faculty believe that a C+ level of competency in CS 1200 pre-requisite material is essential for success in CS 1400, the latter a relatively advanced course.
