RE: Deletion of MCB 4800 – Advanced Video Production

The Department of Communications and Performing Arts is proposing the Deletion of MCB 4800 – Advanced Video Production

Rationale for Change:

We have found that television studio production courses in CUNY and in privateuniversities and colleges are on average more comprehensive and with longer contact hours than found in either MCB 4100 – Television Studio Production (3 credits/3 hours) and our MCB 4800 – Advanced Video Production (3 credits/3 hours).

As MCB 4100 is the required course for the AS Media Arts, we have concluded that the best course of action for the betterment of the degree is to match MCB 4100's content and contact hours to existing television production courses in CUNY and private universities and colleges (see separate submission for this change). Additionally, adjustment in content and contact hours for MCB 4100 will strengthen its articulation to 4-year programs.

It is also important to note that MCB 4800 has not run in several years, even before the pandemic, due to low enrollment, making it even more important to remove it from our degree in favorof infusing MCB 4100 with its advanced content. It is also important to note that both courses use the same textbook, Zettl Video Basics 8, but each course only covers half of the textbook. We have determined that covering the entire textbook in one required course will strengthen and focus our degree.

We are therefore proposing the deletion of MCB 4800 – Advanced Video Production.
