The Art Department is proposing a change in title for Photography I (Art 5100):

Darkroom Photography I

Rationale for Change: New title confers clarity, in terms of the content for perspective enrollees in the course. Our darkroom and film photography courses, ART 5100 - Photography I and ART 5200 - Photography II, were first created in the 1960's. In the early 2000's with the beginning of digital photography, ART 9400 - The Art of Digital Photograph, was created. As digital photography has become mainstream, students are not necessarily thinking of darkroom and film courses, when they enroll in our Photography I and Photography II courses. In turn, a proposed change in course title to Darkroom Photography I would clarify this point for students. In addition, the title change would re-align our course naming to match course names at Queens College BFA in Photography and Imaging, with whom we have an articulation agreement.
