Subject: SD 10, 11 & 12 Deletion Justification

These courses are inconsistent with several bylaws governing the offering of courses and departments. (Articles VIII & IX) They are a remnant of the now defunct department of Student Development. As a result, the college is offering courses without a department, with no faculty, no chair, and no P&B committee. SD 10, 11 & 12 have no academic oversight, no observation and evaluation of instructors, and no assessment. Discussions have taken place regarding how to reach students more broadly with the introductory material covered in this course.

SD 10, 11 & 12 are one credit courses that do not fulfill any major or general education requirement. This results in an extra elective credit for students which creates the possibility for lost credits when transferring.

Given the inherent governance violations along with the lack of any degree requirement, we feel that deletion of these courses is warranted.
