RE: Change in Degree Requirements for the A.S. in Chemical Dependency
Counseling

The Department of Behavioral Sciences and Human Services is proposing a change in degree requirements for the A.S. in Chemical Dependency Counseling.

Inclusion of PSY 1100 – General Psychology under Pathways Flexible Core: Scientific World (Group E).

Rationale for Change:

This change addresses the hidden credit of PSY 1100 within the A.S. in Chemical Dependency Counseling by including it as a required course under Pathways Flexible Core: Scientific World (Group E).

The program is accredited by the National Addiction Studies Accreditation Commission (NASAC) and by the New York Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS), which satisfies the education requirements for the Certification in Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counseling - Trainee Certification (CASAC-T). In turn, we are able to request a waiver to require a particular course in the Common Core, otherwise more than the minimum credits for the degree may be necessary.
