RE: Change in Degree Requirements for A.S. in Early Childhood Education/Child

Care

The Department of Behavioral Sciences and Human Services is proposing a change in degree requirements for the A.S. in Early Childhood Education/Child Care. The changes include the following:

- Including PSY 1100, General Psychology under Degree Requirements
- Discontinuing the Concentration in Infancy/Toddler Development
- Including the courses listed under the Early Childhood/Child Care concentration under the overall degree requirements
- Deleting HIS 7000, Historical Geography as an option
- Under Electives for the degree, including the recommendation that students take PSY 3000, Child and Adolescent Development if Elective credits are available.

#### **Rationale for Change:**

#### Including PSY 1100, General Psychology under Degree Requirements

This change addresses the hidden credit of PSY 1100 within the A.S.in Early Childhood Education/Child Care by including it as a requirement for the degree program

#### Discontinuing Infancy/Toddler Concentration

The Infancy/Toddler Development concentration consists of two courses, EDC 3200, Infant/Toddler Development, and EDC 9400, Supervised Instructional Experience in Infant/Toddler Education. Currently, the majority of the degree requirements (9 courses, 24 credits) focus on early childhood education and childcare. In a review of the field and the current structure of the concentration within the degree program, we believe that we do not have a credible concentration in Infancy/Toddler Development, as two courses do not provide an adequate focus particularly on infancy as toddlerhood is already included under early childhood.

Additionally, enrollment within the concentration has averaged 10.6% (22 students) over a three-year period. This has made it incredibly difficult to run the required fieldwork course within the concentration (Note: EDC 3200 is a required course under the Birth-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade concentration under the A.S. in Education Studies and accounts for the majority of enrollment within that course).

#### Sunset date:

Based on the enrollment data for the Infancy/Toddler Development concentration and to accommodate the currently enrolled students we are proposing a Sunset Date of FALL 2024.

# <u>Inclusion of courses listed under the Early Childhood/Child Care concentration under the degree requirements</u>

Without the Infancy/Toddler Development concentration, it would make sense to absorb the two courses listed under the Early Childhood Education Childcare concentration into the degree of the same.

#### Deletion of HIS 7000, Historical Geography

This course was required of the articulation agreement with the College of Staten Island. As their degree program underwent a significant number of changes it no longer articulated with our A.S. in Early Childhood Education/Child Care. We removed reference to the articulation at the SPRING 2018 Curriculum Committee and we are now removing the associated course.

#### Recommendation Under Electives:

In order to include PSY 1100, General Psychology, under the degree requirements it was necessary to remove PSY 3000, Child and Adolescent Development. The course does not serve as a prerequisite to any of the Early Childhood Education courses and in turn, we felt it adequate to recommend the course for students who did not take the course to fulfill Pathways Flexible Core: Individual and Society (Group D) and have elective credits.
