The Department of Behavioral Sciences and Human Services is proposing a change in Prerequisite for EDC 9105, Supervised Instructional Experience in Education I

FROM:

EDC 2100 and EDC 3000 or EDC 3200, with a grade of "C" and Passed, exempt, or completed developmental course work for the CUNY Assessment Tests in Reading and Writing

TO:

EDC 2100 with a grade of "C" and Passed, exempt, or completed developmental course work for the CUNY Assessment Tests in Reading and Writing.

Rationale for Change:

EDC 2100 provides students with the necessary skills and information for preparation for the field. Removing EDC 3000 as a prerequisite to the field does not limit where the course can be completed, allowing the student to take the course with a number of EDC courses within the A.S. Early Childhood Education/Child Care.

EDC 3200 is a requirement of the Infant/Toddler Development concentration that is being proposed to be discontinued.
