The Department of Communications & Performing Arts is proposing a reactivation of JRL 9249 – Journalism Internship

FROM:

Prerequisite: JRL 4100

Description:

Students will be placed on community newspapers or in community-relations offices for practical work in the operations of a community publication.

TO:

Prerequisite: JRL 3200 & JRL 7000 (Scepter Practicum)

Description:

Practical and professional experience working for a community newspaper/ public / community relations firm or indie print and digital publications. While there, students are assigned to work on covering community news, learning basic newspaper/website layout, website design, photo and audio editing and social media for journalists.

Rationale:

Reactivation of JRL 9249 – Journalism Internship will allow for its inclusion in our reviser A.S. Journalism degree program. It will serve as an essential part of the curriculum, giving students exposure to industry experience.
