- A professional development plan to support CE, possibly to include a winter/spring workshop and an event to showcase student work
- Strategies for bridging CE with Service Learning/Experiential Learning and large campus events such as Eco Fest
- A process for the development and scaling of CE-certified component experiences
- An implementation plan for the assessment of CE-certified courses and components.
- Recording of transcript notations for CE-certified courses and experiences
