Committee members will review courses via the CUNYfirst course review system (training will be provided) and discuss/vote on courses remotely or in person. The committee may also be asked to review courses submitted via the student appeals process and to contribute to guiding the

learning outcomes of select major or gateway courses. Each committee member will receive one course release for the two-year term.

Each college will have the opportunity to have one representative on each of the two subcommittees.
