It's as Easy as...ABCDE

The Summer College For Kids program is open to girls and boys ages 7 through 12. This program meets weekday mornings and full-days for your choice of 4, 6, or 8 weeks!

The Morning program options are:

Monday and Wednesday **or** Tuesday and Thursday **or** Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, for four weeks.

The Full-day program meets on: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday and includes a nutritious lunch, snack and beverage. Parents may enroll their children for any one of the 5 Plans offered.

The morning plans (Plan "A" & "B") consist of two courses per morning (One academic class and one active class or two academic classes). Exam Prep (CKI) classes count as two academic classes.

The full-day plans (Plans "C", "D" & "E") consist of four classes per Monday/Wednesday schedule with one Group Activity and four classes per Tue/Thurs schedule with one Group Activity.

Group Activities

The last session of your child's full day program will consist of his or her choice of group activities. These fun-filled activities will bring together larger groups of your child's peers, while providing them with more freedom of choice to decide in which activities to participate within each group environment.

TEST PREP COURSES

EACH OF THESE COUNTS AS 2 ACADEMIC CLASSES

Note: These are two-hour classes and include a short break.

CKI 01 Language Arts Exam - Grades: 3, 4 and 5 AM

This class will cover all material necessary for the Language Arts Exam for the above grades.

CKI 02 Math Exam Prep - Grades: 3, 4 and 5 AM

This class will cover all material necessary for the Math Exam for the above grade

CKI 03 Social Studies Exam Prep - Grade 5 AM

This class will cover all material necessary for the Social Studies Exam for the above grade.

CKI 20 Cooking AM TUESDAYS AND THURSDAYS ONLY

Learn how to make healthy, fun and easy meals. Learn how to make favorites like pizza, ice cream, ravioli and macaroni and cheese from scratch, and design your own menu for a special family meal. This course runs for two hours.

This class is available only with the full-day program.

Designed for children 10-12 years old.

ACADEMIC COURSES

CKS 01 Reading and Writing Made Fun AM & PM

Individual and small group instruction to improve basic reading skills and learn the essentials of writing: theme, plot, characterization and description to express yourself on paper.

CKS 11 Fun With Numbers AM & PM

Improve basic arithmetic skills in a fun and non-threatening manner.

CKS 15 Chess for Kids AM & PM

Get an early jump on the fun and excitement of chess and find out why most kids consider chess a "cool" game.

CKS 31 Mad Scientist AM & PM

Experience life as a mad scientist. Work with bubbling potions, learn the art of slime-making, or create your own air freshener. Bring out your Jekyll in Hyding!

CKS 34 Marine Monsters AM & PM

You will explore the marine environment with hands-on activities and experiments, learn to identify fish and visit KCC's aquarium.

CKS 48 Piano: Beginner AM & PM

Learn to read music and develop music appreciation and manual dexterity. Play "Chopsticks" or "Happy Birthday" for your family and friends.

CKS 55 Be An Artist AM & PM

Use pen and ink, pencil, charcoal, and other media as you draw what pleases you. Apply principles of composition, form, light, shade, value and perspective in your work. A list of suggested materials will be distributed at the first class. Please bring an 11" X 14" pad to your first class.

CKS 74 Fishing AM & PM

Bring your rod and reel. Bait will be provided. The Kingsborough campus is right on the water, providing terrific places to fish, weather permitting.

CKS 75 PowerPoint PM

Find out how to use the Internet as a tool for research, presentations, and entertainment. Incorporate PowerPoint into school presentations using graphics to illustrate reports. The safe and responsible use of this important and expanding medium will be stressed.

CKS 81 Code Blue ER AM & PM

Learn how to react to emergencies inside and outside the home so that you can come to the rescue if the situation arises. Learn basic CPR, the function of various parts of the body, pressure points, when and how to seek additional assistance.

ACTIVE COURSES

CKS 84 All That Jazz AM & PM

This class is hip-hop, funk, jazz and dance music all wrapped into one. Love music videos and like to dance? This is the class for you!

CKS 90 Swimming AM

Learn the principles of swimming and basic water safety. Beginner and advanced sections. Beginners gain confidence in the water. For those with some swimming ability; the emphasis is on kicking, stroking and breathing.

There is a minimum height requirement of 52" to enroll for Swimming. You will be measured! Bring towel, swimsuit & combination lock.

CKS 92 Basketball Clinic AM & PM

Various offensive maneuvers, defensive strategies and regulations of the game will be reviewed and played. By the end of the course, you will be dribbling and jump-shooting like a pro!
