

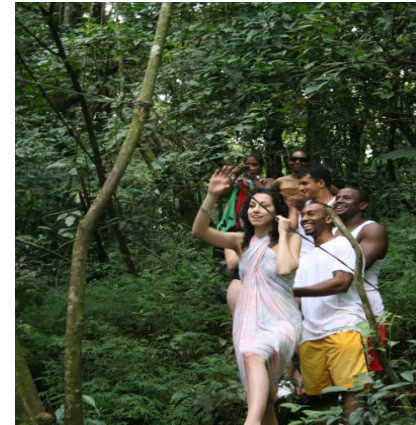
Summer 2009 in Costa Rica

This program is designed to give students an overview of Costa Rica through Spanish Language classes and peace and reconciliation studies.
