THEME: <u>Beautiful Patterns in Nature</u> This photo essay will focus on the endless patterns that nature provides. Whether it is the branching pattern a tree, the spiral swirl of a shell or the prefect ring of petals on a flower, nature is full of patterns for the keen observer. Part C: PHOTOGRAPHS

Applicant must submit the photo-essay consisting of **10 original images** which they took using either a digital or print camera. The images must be submitted with this application as.jpg images embedded into a PowerPoint and saved as a PDF.
