
Dear Campus Community,

- New freshmen and transfer registration began November 29th.

Recruitment Life

We received an overwhelming response to our call for volunteers. Volunteers will join our recruiters at virtual and in person events to discuss their programs or their experiences at KCC. At present our roster has 21 active individuals who will be paired up with recruiters depending on interest and availability.

GED to KCC

EM has partnered with Continuing Education to reach out students who have passed the TASC exam and encourage them to apply to our degree programs. Students are invited to dedicated dates/times where staff from our One Stop can assist with completing their application.

New Start Chats

EM now offers Wednesdays with Wayne, which provides an opportunity for our New Start students and partners to discuss any challenges they are having or offer information on transitioning to KCC.

Justice Involved Students

EM has partnered with Detention Centers and other facilities to reach out to young adults who may be detained by the courts to assist them in starting their college career. We offer information session on how students can complete their degrees completely online through our FLEX program.

15 to Finish

■ EM is partnering with Academic Affairs and Communications and Marketing to encourage students to take 15 credits to finish in 2 years. Registrar has launched its "Encouragement Screen" which appears when a student has registered for 12 credits and has a 2.0 GPA. The CUNYFirst popup screen encourages students to

register for up to 18 credits at no additional cost to expedite their time to graduation.
