

Does the student speak another language at home? (Degree students only)









Basic Skills Needs First-Time Freshmen Fall 2013 to Fall 2017



Basic Skills Test Performance First-Time Freshmen Fall 2013 to Fall 2017





Credit Students Enrollment Headcount Fall 2013 to Fall 2017





Credit Students By Full-time and Part Time Status Fall 2013 to Fall 2017










