WAYS TO GET HELP WITH WRITING...



1. Visit the Assignment Lab in L219.

The Writing Across the Curriculum Program offers students in W and Honors sections the support of advanced graduate students from the CUNY Graduate Center. Call extension 5405 to make an appointment for an individual tutoring session, or simply stop by the Assignment Lab, located in the Reading and Writing Center (L219). Writing Fellows are available during the following hours:

- Monday - Thursday, generally between 10 am and 3 pm
- You'll want to bring your draft, your ideas about the assignment, and the assignment itself.



2. Send in your draft via email.

If you can't make it to the Assignment Lab, simply email the Writing Fellows and attach your draft as a Word file. In the message, let us know the course for which you are writing this assignment and the name of your professor. Then describe the assignment. What are the requirements for this paper? Where are you in your thinking about the draft? What kind of feedback would be useful to you? When a Fellow responds, be ready to join an email conversation about this paper.
